AS IT WAS IN THE BEGINNING...

"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever." (Hebrews 13:8)

Pilgrimages are designed to remind us of our journey in faith back to our heavenly Father. The Marian Shrine at Walsingham has been a place of pilgrimage since the 11th century (interrupted for three hundred years after destruction of the Priory by Henry VIII in 1538) attracting people from many countries who came to receive strength from God to continue their journey through life.

More than 20 years ago a different kind of pilgrimage was introduced by the Prince of Peace Community under the title of "New Dawn in the Church", attracting large numbers from various countries to participate in a five-day event with a comprehensive programme to suit people of all ages.

This year the theme of the Conference is "As it was in the beginning..."

As in previous years we have invited a team of gifted speakers from various countries to take us further into this topic. In addition to the programme for adults, special events have been arranged for the children, teenagers and young adults. The family camp, more favourably sited, has grown considerably in recent years aiming to bring families together more closely, forming new and lasting friendships.

The central event each day will be the celebration of the Eucharist. There will also be workshops, Healing and Reconciliation services. Suitable time for private prayer with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will also be allocated. A traditional feature of the Pilgrimage will be recitation of the rosary during a procession to the site of the Holy House in the Priory grounds.

In this time of confusion and uncertainty throughout the world may grace be poured out abundantly during this Conference and received with thanksgiving by all of us, so that others will see a transformation in our lives, and ask us for an "account of the faith that is in us", giving us a fresh opportunity to be effective witnesses to the Resurrection and a sign of hope for the world.

REGISTRATION – ALL DELEGATES (INCLUDING BABIES) MUST BE REGISTERED. PLEASE PRE REGISTER BY MONDAY 14TH JULY 2008.

Entry to the Conference will be strictly controlled for security reasons. Badge holders only will be admitted. Registration will commence on Monday 4th August at 11am.

CONFERENCE INFORMATION

The Conference starts on Monday 4th August with Mass at 3.30pm in the main marquee and concludes at lunchtime after Mass on Saturday 9th August. The Conference site is the National Roman Catholic Shrine of Our Lady, at Walsingham in Norfolk. The Shrine is located at Houghton St Giles, which is one mile from the village of Little Walsingham. We regret that animals are not allowed at the Conference, with the exception of guide dogs.

CHILD CARE

PARENTS REMAIN RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES

An area is set aside for parents with small children.

AGES [0-4], [5-7], & [8-10]: there is a special programme during part of the day for these age groups.

YOUTH MINISTRY: CROSS STREAMS

We have two youth streams for young people and young adults; one for 11 to 14 year olds and one for those aged 15+.

Those in these age groups are invited to attend our Cross Streams youth ministry, where they will be able to partake in an exciting timetable of events tailored to their own age group. They mostly have their own programme, but do join the main Conference for special events. The first session takes place at 7pm on Monday. There will also be evening entertainment/activities in the Cross Streams youth ministry area after the cessation of each day's timetabled events. DONATIONS – NO FEE, BUT NOT FREE!

Our aim is to welcome everyone who wishes to attend the New Dawn Conference. Therefore there is no fixed conference fee. We request that delegates freely contribute towards our costs according to each one's means. Those who have much can give much. Those who have little may give little. However we still have to meet enormous bills without any alternative source of income. The suggested donation is Adults £85, Ages 5 – 21 £30.

MEALS

Meals are available from our on-site caterer, as there are no restaurants near the Conference site. Lunch and Dinner are catered for at £4 per meal (£40 for the week); £1 per meal for 8's and under (£10 for the week). We commence with dinner on Monday and conclude with Saturday lunch. Tea, coffee, cold drinks and biscuits will be available to purchase on site at breaks during the Conference.

CAMPING AND CARAVANNING (Family Camp)

There are camping facilities near the Conference site, equipped with toilets, showers and drinking water. Due to the continued overwhelming demand experienced in 2007 *it is essential to book in advance* – we must know in advance how many pilgrims will be arriving to camp.

Please note, in respecting the large number of families with young children on the family camp, there is a midnight curfew. In addition, bookings for individuals under 26 years old, or groups mostly under the age of 26 years, may be re-allocated to the Youth Camp. Tents are not provided.

(NOTE-Fakenham racecourse campsite (01328 862 388) is 5 miles from the Conference site – please make your own arrangements.)

YOUNG ADULTS CAMP

Exclusively for young adults aged 16 or over, situated adjacent to the Cross Streams youth ministry area.

If under 18 (DOB after 03/08/90), please enclose written parental permission, which should include emergency contact details and the name of a responsible adult attending the Conference who will act as legal guardian. There is a 1.00am curfew on the young adults camp. Unless you are under 18 or are in a group of more than six people, it is not essential to book in advance for the youth camp, but we would strongly encourage you to do so if possible.

NEW DAWN ACCOMMODATION

We have arranged accommodation at the Wells Field Study Centre at Wells-next-the-Sea (approx.8 miles from Walsingham) and also at Holt Hall (approx.15 miles from Walsingham). Both of these sites offer accommodation in dormitories for up to 8 people. There are a limited number of twin rooms available at Holt Hall. There are no single rooms.

An accommodation list containing some local B&B addresses is available for those who wish to make their own arrangements. Please send large SAE.

The cost for Holt Hall is £24 per person per night, bed and breakfast and reservations run from Sunday or Monday evening to Saturday morning.

The cost for Wells Field Study Centre is £24 per person per night, bed and breakfast and reservations run from Monday evening to Saturday morning.

If you do not have transport you will need to book our **ACCOMMODATION COACH** (see below)
