Donations

*New Dawn is run by the Prince of Peace Community. In order that no-one should be excluded on the grounds of genuine poverty, there is no fixed Conference fee. We rely upon God's Providence and your generous response to His prompting to cover the overall costs which are about **£200,000**. This **does not include** Camping, Accommodation, Transport and Food which are charged at cost, as required. We estimate that our costs will be covered if we receive **a minimum donation of £125 per adult and £40 per child and young person**. We know that some cannot afford this amount so we work on the long established Christian principle: "Let him who has some give for him who has none". **All** are asked to contribute in accordance with their conscience and ability to subscribe. **Everyone** should be able to give something! We thank you in advance for your generosity.*

Consider the following which we need to pay for at the site:

Hire of fields - Marquees and cabins – Lighting and sound provision (including sound crew) – Speakers' expenses – Electricity, telecommunications, water & sanitation – seating arrangements and other furniture - requirements for children's and youth ministries – flowers, candles, altar breads and altar wine – printing and postage etc, etc.

Gift Aid

If you are a UK Taxpayer please consider Gift Aiding your donation as this means we can claim from Revenue and Customs 25 pence for every pound you donate. If you are paying the donation for other members of your family or group, you may include them in your donation rather than separately.

Please sign the declaration on the Registration Form

To qualify for Gift Aid, what you pay in income tax or capital gains tax must cover all Gift Aid donations made in the same tax year to charities and Community Amateur Sports Clubs.

Family Camp

Over 1000 people camp at New Dawn. It is a great achievement and creates a warm and friendly atmosphere. Having so many people means there is a real need for co-operation in several key areas. We have a totally dedicated small team on the Family Camp who give their all, practically 24 hours per day during the Conference.

General tidying up of the site requires a lot of hard work, especially at the end of the Conference, so if families could offer some time to assist in this, the workload would be much lighter.

Youth Camp for Young People 16-25

- The Youth Camp opens Sunday 29th July at 12 noon
- Up to 5 nights (Sun – Thursday) @ £8.00 per night
- There is a 12 midnight curfew on the Youth Camp
- **Alcohol is not permitted on the Youth Camp**

Those under 18 (Date of Birth after 01/8/2000) wishing to stay on the Youth Camp must provide written parental consent at time of registration. This should include the name and contact details of a responsible adult attending the Conference who will act as legal guardian. The running of the Youth Camp depends on a small dedicated team who work tirelessly from setting up the camp on Sunday to packing away at the end of the Conference.

Please offer to give some of your time to assist by speaking to a team member when you arrive on site.

Youth Ministry

Parents / Guardians remain responsible for their children (under 18) at all times. We have three youth streams for young people and young adults.

Year 7 – Year 9

Year 10 – Year 13

Age 19 - 25

All attendees for Youth Ministry must register for the Conference on the main site before joining the Youth Ministry team.

Young people should register in the school year group that they have just completed, *not the school year which they will be entering in September*. The Youth Ministry will mostly have their own programme. There will be evening entertainment / activities in the Youth Ministry area most evenings after the timetabled events. It would be appreciated if as many children as possible are pre-registered as this will speed up registration. Parents please note: If you are intending to attend Mass on the day you arrive and want your children to attend the Children's Liturgy of the Word you must arrive in good time to make sure that your children are registered at the Children's Ministry before Mass starts. Unregistered children will not be able to attend, and NO CHILD under 5 years will be allowed to stay in the Children's Ministry tent at any time.

Crèche for children under five

The crèche for children under five years will be located near the main tent, and there will be a screen provided to show the Mass and other sessions taking place on the stage. Parents must be present with their children at all times when using the Crèche.

Accommodation

Pilgrim Bureau – Elmham House – Little Walsingham (approx. 1 mile from Conference site). We have strictly limited availability at this establishment. Accommodation requested for the Pilgrim Bureau **MUST** be paid for **IN FULL** within 10 days of receiving your booking form. NB: *If your registration form and FULL PAYMENT is not received within 10 days of booking, the room will be reallocated.*

If you have not confirmed your place, you **WILL** be placed on a waiting list. Accommodation arranged through New Dawn will only be booked from Sunday, 29th July until Friday morning, 3rd August. Anyone requiring additional nights either before or after the Conference **MUST** book direct with Elmham House on 01328 820217.
